## **PREFACE**

Directorate of Economics & Statistics, Gujarat State prepares and publishes, every year, the estimates of State Domestic Product (SDP) both at current and constant prices. The estimates of SDP upto the year 2008-09 were continued with the base year 1999-2000. The shift in the base year from 1999-00 to 2004-05 has been introduced from the year 2009-10. As such, this is the first year with the new base i.e. 2004-05, presents the estimates of Gross / Net State Domestic Product, Gross Domestic Product, Net National Product, a set of disaggregated statements for each sector of economy and statewise estimates of Gross / Net State Domestic Product at current prices and constant (2004-05) prices for the period 2004-05 to 2009-10. A brief analytical write-up giving an overview of the economy, as observed, is also included in this publication. These estimates are prepared following the methodology / guidelines, released by the CSO, New Delhi, Government of India.

I am thankful to officials of National Accounts Division, CSO for timely providing requisite data and guidance. I extend my gratitude to various Heads of Departments of State Government, Departmental and Non-departmental Commercial Undertakings of their cooperation in making available requisite data for preparing the SDP.

Suggestions towards improvement in preparation of SDP estimates will be appreciated.

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## **STATE DOMESTIC PRODUCT – An Overview**

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### **1.1 Introduction**

State Domestic Product (SDP) in common parlance known as “State Income” is a measure in monetary terms of the volume of all goods and services produced during a given period of time within the geographical boundaries of the state, accounted without duplication. This is the most important single economic indicator used to measure the growth and to study the structural changes taking place in the economy. SDP estimates over a period of time reveal the extent and direction of the changes in the level of economic development. Sectoral composition of SDP gives an idea about the relative position of different sectors in the economy over a period of time, which not only indicates the real structural changes taking place in the economy, but also facilitates in formulation of the plans for overall economic development.

The Per Capita Net State Domestic Product, also known as Per Capita Income is used to determine both the absolute and relative performance of the state economy. It is also considered as an important tool to measure the regional disparities.

The estimates of SDP are prepared both at current and at constant prices. The estimates of SDP at current prices are obtained by evaluating the product at prices prevailing during the year. The estimates of SDP at constant prices are prepared by evaluating the product of the current year with base year prices in order to eliminate the effects of price changes and to measure the real growth of economy.

The base year needs to be revised periodically in order to reflect the changes taking place within the economy. The change in the base year at the state level is adopted on the lines of the change adopted at the national level by the Central Statistics Office (CSO). The CSO has shifted the base year from 1999-2000 to 2004-05 on 29<sup>th</sup> January, 2010. Thereafter, the CSO convened the National workshop on New Series of SDP during 26<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2010 at Puducherry for the benefit of the states to introduce the new base year (2004-05) alongwith the methodological changes, improvement in the data base and also new emerging areas in the economy.

The new series, besides shifting of base year for 1999-2000 to 2004-05, incorporates latest available data, new economic activities, expansion of coverage, improvement in procedures and the suggestions and guidelines provided by the CSO.

In the New Series of National Accounts Statistics with base year 2004-05, following new data sources have been used.

NSS 61<sup>st</sup> Round (2004-05) on employment and unemployment surveys

NSS 62<sup>nd</sup> Round (2005-06) on unorganized manufacturing

NSS 63<sup>rd</sup> Round (2006-07) on services sectors

All India Livestock Census 2007

Population Census, 2001 ; and

Fourth All India Census of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, 2006-07

Also, the results of various studies undertaken by the CSO through the Ministry of Agriculture, Ministry of Environment and Forestry, CSO's input-output transactions tables and the Ministry of Agriculture's cost of cultivation studies have been used in New Series for updating the rates and ratios used to estimate the production/consumption of fodder, market charges paid by the farmers, yield rates of meat, meat products and forestry and the trade and transport margins.

With this shift in the base year, the estimates of State Domestic Product (SDP) for both at current and at constant (2004-05) prices have been revised from 2004-05 to 2008-09 for all the sectors of economy. The quick estimates of SDP for the year 2009-10 are prepared with the new base year 2004-05.

## **1.2 The State Economy**

The state is among the top six major State economies and it contributes about 7.0 per cent to the GDP at National level during the year 2009-10, though the state's share to India's population is about 4.99 percent. For the Eleventh Five Year Plan, a very high growth target of 11.2 per cent has been set for Gujarat State by Planning Commission, Government of India.

### **1.2.1 Gross State Domestic Product**

Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) at factor cost at constant (2004-05) prices in 2009-10 has been estimated at Rs. 331633 crore as against Rs. 300847 crore in 2008-09 registering a growth of 10.2 per cent during the year. At current prices, GSDP at factor cost in 2009-10 has been estimated at Rs. 429356 crore as

against Rs. 367745 crore in 2008-09, registering a growth of 16.8 per cent during the year. The higher growth in the economy during the year 2009-10 can be mainly attributed to manufacturing, electricity, construction and communication sectors, which have contributed 11 to 34.6 per cent growth during 2009-10 at constant (2004-05) prices.

The performance of the State economy in terms of GSDP in absolute values and percentage change over previous year at current and at constant (2004-05) prices are presented below.

### 1.2.2 Net State Domestic Product

The State Income i.e Net State Domestic Product (NSDP) at factor cost at constant (2004-05) prices in 2009-10 has been estimated at Rs. 283930 crore as against Rs. 256197 crore in 2008-09, showing a growth of 10.8 per cent during the year. At current prices, the NSDP in 2009-10 is estimated at Rs. 370400 crore as against Rs. 314899 crore in 2008-09 showing a growth of 17.6 per cent during the year.

### 1.2.3 Per Capita Income

The Per Capita Income (i.e. Per Capita NSDP at factor cost) at constant (2004-05) prices has been estimated at Rs. 49030 in 2009-10 as against Rs. 44861 in 2008-09, registering a growth of 9.3 per cent during the year. The per capita income at

current prices has been estimated at Rs. 63961 in 2009-10 as against Rs. 55140 in 2008-09, showing an increase of 16.0 per cent during the year.

#### 1.2.4 Sectoral contribution (GSDP)

Since 1960-61, there has been a significant structural shift in the State economy. Like other developing economies, there is a gradual increase in share of Industry and Services sectors and thereby decline of share in primary sectors. At current prices, in 1960-61, the share of primary sector was 41.8 per cent which went down to 38.7 per cent in 1980-81 and further declined to 18.2 per cent in 2009-10. In 1960-61, the share of secondary sector in economy was 25.7 per cent which increased to 29.0 per cent in 1980-81 and further grew up to 36.9 per cent in 2009-10 indicating that the secondary sector has gained momentum after the year 1980-81. Where as, the share of tertiary sector in economy was 32.5 per cent in 1960-61 which remained stable in 1980-81 at 32.3 per cent and thereafter gained a steep rise and registered a share of 44.9 per cent in 2009-10. The sectoral contribution by broad sectors i.e primary, secondary and tertiary sectors at current and at constant (2004-05) prices is given below.

The share of primary, secondary and tertiary sectors has been reported to be as 14.2 per cent, 38.6 per cent and 47.2 per cent respectively to the total GSDP (Rs. 331633 crore) in 2009-10 at constant (2004-05) prices. The share of these sectors in the base year 2004-05 was reported to be as 19.5 per cent, 36.5 per cent and 44.0 per cent respectively.

The share of primary, secondary and tertiary sectors has been reported to be 18.2 per cent, 36.9 per cent and 44.9 per cent respectively to the GSDP (Rs.429356 crore) in 2009-10 at current prices.

### 1.2.5 Sectoral Growth by broad sectors at Constant (2004-05) Prices

The growth in agriculture sector has shown fluctuations over the years. This effect of negative fluctuations has largely been compensated by secondary and tertiary sectors. Also, these two sectors have helped in sustaining the overall economy on a positive growth path, which may be seen in the below table.

## Sectoral Performance of the State Economy

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### 2.1 Agriculture

The performance of agriculture sector has been fluctuating at times with the fluctuation in rain fall. This has given its impact on agriculture sector and thereby in economy as a whole, since its contribution towards total GSDP has remained at around 14 per cent. The gross value added from this sector at current prices for the year 2009-10 is estimated at Rs. 59180 crore as against Rs. 50132 crore in 2008-09, showing a high growth rate of 18.0 per cent. At constant (2004-05) prices it is estimated at Rs. 33677 crore as against Rs. 33592 crore in 2008-09 by showing a very low growth rate of 0.3 per cent during the year 2009-10 (Statement-5 & 8).

During the year 2009-10, the state agriculture experienced erratic and inadequate rainfall, which has resulted in low production of important crops. The production of important crops in the State is shown in table below.

The table indicates that the production level of food grains, groundnut and oil seeds crop group during 2009-10 have remained substantially lower than that of the year 2008-09. The large impact of rainfall on agriculture growth may be seen from the following table.

It may be seen from the above table that area and production of food grains are largely influenced by the rainfall fluctuations over the years. It has been observed that during six out of ten odd years, the rainfall registered a negative growth.

## 2.2 Livestock

Milk and dairy products of this sector have been contributing significantly. Contribution from this sector in the GSDP is around 5.0 per cent. The gross value of output from this sector at current prices in 2009-10 is estimated at Rs. 20434 crore as against Rs. 17530 crore of 2008-09, registering a growth rate of 16.6 per cent. At constant (2004-05) prices, the gross value of output for 2009-10 is estimated at Rs. 13298 crore as against Rs. 12724 crore of 2008-09, registering a growth rate of 4.5 per cent. The milk group constitutes about 90 per cent to the total value added from this sector. The year wise production of milk is shown as under (Statement-17).

The above table indicates that milk production has consistently gone up from 50.59 Lakh MT in 1998-99 to 88.43 Lakh MT in 2009-10, with an average annual growth of 5.2 per cent.

### 2.3 Forestry and Logging

The average contribution of this sector in the State economy is around 1.5 per cent. The gross value added from this sector at current prices is estimated at Rs. 5390 crore for the year 2009-10 as against Rs. 4979 crore during 2008-09 registering a growth rate of 8.3 per cent. During the same period, the GSDP at constant (2004-05) prices is estimated at Rs. 4656 crore as against Rs. 4561 crore in 2008-09, registering a growth rate of 2.1 per cent (Statement-5 & 8).

### 2.4 Fishing

The contribution of this sector in the total GSDP of the state is around 0.8 per cent. The gross value added from this sector at current prices is estimated at Rs. 2948 crore for 2009-10 as against Rs. 2682 crore for previous year, registering a growth rate of 9.9 per cent. At constant (2004-05) prices, it is estimated at Rs. 1886 crore for 2009-10 as against Rs. 1852 crore in 2008-09 registering a growth rate of 1.8 per cent (Statement-5 & 8).

### 2.5 Mining and Quarrying

The mineral sector is one of the core sectors for the industrial development of the State. Fuel minerals group i.e petroleum, natural gas and lignite constitute major part of this sector. Average contribution of this sector is also around 3.0 per cent in the economy of the state. The gross value added from this sector at current prices is estimated at Rs. 10580 crore in 2009-10 as against Rs. 9090 crore of the previous year, registering a growth rate of 16.4 per cent. During the same period, the gross value added from this sector at

constant (2004-05) prices is estimated at Rs. 6897 crore as against Rs. 6873 crore in 2008-09, showing a growth rate of 0.3 per cent (Statement –5 & 8).

## 2.6 Manufacturing

The State is among the most leading industrial states in the Country. This sector comprises of both registered and un-registered manufacturing sector. It contributes around 28 percent to the GSDP.

The value added from the registered manufacturing sector for the year 2009-10 at current prices is estimated at Rs. 90010 crore as against Rs. 80778 crore in 2008-09, registering a growth rate of 11.4 per cent. During the same period, the value added at constant (2004-05) prices is estimated at Rs. 71537 crore for 2009-10 as against Rs. 64460 crore in 2008-09 registering a growth rate of 11.0 per cent (Statement–5 & 8).

The value added from un registered manufacturing sector for the year 2009-10 at current prices is estimated at Rs. 23319 crore as against Rs. 20629 crore in 2008-09, registering a growth rate of 13.0 per cent . At constant (2004-05) prices, the value added from this sector for 2009-10 is estimated at Rs. 19347 crore as against Rs. 17433 crore for 2008-09 showing a growth rate of 11.0 per cent (Statement– 5 & 8).

## 2.7 Electricity, Gas and Water supply

The critical input require for Industrial progress is electricity. This sector generally requires huge investment and special attention from the Government. The contribution from this sector is around 3.0 percent. The gross value added from this sector is estimated at Rs. 11455 crore at current prices in 2009-10 as against Rs. 8633 crore in 2008-09 showing a growth rate of 32.7 per cent. At constant (2004-05) prices, the GSDP is estimated Rs. 10499 crore in 2009-10 as against Rs. 7927 crore in previous year registering a growth rate of 32.4 per cent (Statement–5 & 8).

## 2.8 Construction

This sector is gaining momentum and contributing around 7.0 percent in the State economy. The value added from this sector at current prices is estimated at Rs. 33724 crore for the year 2009-10 as against Rs. 28796 crore in previous year showing a rise of 17.1 per cent. At constant (2004-05) prices, the value added from this sector is estimated at Rs. 26592 crore in 2009-10 as against Rs. 23043 crore in previous year registering a growth rate of 15.4 per cent (Statement–5 & 8).

## 2.9 Trade, Hotels and Restaurants

The contribution of this sector to GSDP is around 18 percent. The value added from this sector at current prices is estimated at Rs. 82455 crore for the year 2009-10 as against Rs. 69528 crore in previous year showing an increase of 18.6 per cent. At constant (2004-05) prices, the value added from this sector is estimated at Rs. 64150 crore in 2009-10 as against Rs. 57897 crore in previous year registering a growth rate of 10.8 per cent (Statement– 5 & 8).

## 2.10 Transport by other means

The contribution from this sector is around 4.0 percent to the GSDP. The value added from this sector at current prices is estimated at Rs. 18926 crore for the year 2009-10 as against Rs. 15942 crore in previous year showing an increase of 18.7 per cent. At constant (2004-05) prices, the value added from this sector is estimated at Rs. 14669 crore in 2009-10 as against Rs. 13891 crore in previous year registering a growth rate of 5.6 percent (Statement– 5 & 8).

## 2.11 Real Estate, Ownership of Dwellings and Business Services

These sectors contribute around 6.5 percent to GSDP. The value added from these sectors at current prices is estimated at Rs. 27978 crore for the year 2009-10 as against Rs. 23459 crore in previous year showing an increase of 19.3 per cent. At constant (2004-05) prices, the value added from these sectors is estimated at Rs. 18298 crore in 2009-10 as against Rs. 17308 crore in previous year registering a growth rate of 5.7 per cent. The growth in these sectors is mainly attributed to technological improvement and advancement in the business services (Statement–5 & 8).

## 2.12 Public Administration

The contribution of this sector is around 3.0 percent. The value added from this sector at current prices is estimated at Rs. 13238 crore for the year 2009-10 as against Rs. 10673 crore in previous year showing an increase of 24.0 per cent. At constant (2004-05) prices, the value added from this sector is estimated at Rs. 9374 crore in 2009-10 as against Rs. 8513 crore in previous year registering a growth of 10.1 per cent (Statement– 5 & 8).

## 2.13 Other services

The economic activities covered under other services group are :

The contribution of above sectors to the economy is around 5.0 percent. The value added from these sectors at current prices is estimated at Rs. 20927 crore for the year 2009-10 as against Rs. 16806 crore in previous year showing an increase of 24.5 per cent. At constant (2004-05) prices, the value added from these sectors is estimated at Rs. 14622 crore in 2009-10 as against Rs. 13288 crore in previous year registering a growth rate of 10.0 per cent (Statement– 5 & 8).

### 2.14 Supra-regional sector

Supra regional sector consists of railways, communication, banking and insurance. Since operation of the services from these sectors being non-coterminous with the geographical boundaries of the State, the value added estimates from these sectors are prepared by the CSO, Government of India and apportioned to the states based on certain physical indicators.

At current prices, the contribution to total GSDP from railways, communication and banking and insurance sectors is 0.5, 1.4 and 4.9 per cent respectively during the year 2009-10. The value added from these sectors at current prices is estimated at Rs. 29135 crore for the year 2009-10 as against Rs. 25537 crore in previous year showing an increase of 14.1 per cent. At constant (2004-05) prices, the value added from these sectors is estimated at Rs. 35355 crore in 2009-10 as against Rs. 30145 crore in previous year registering a growth rate of 17.3 per cent.
